1. Nuclear Abolition Day on June 25th

Nuclear Abolition Day is an annual global day of action for a treaty to outlaw and eliminate all nuclear weapons. It is coordinated by the **International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons** (ICAN). The date changes from year to year depending on significant events. On the 2010 global day of action, more than 80 actions took place in 30 countries. These included street demonstrations, benefit gigs, nuclear-free picnics, vigils, marches and education workshops. ICAN encourages people to be as creative as possible. All actions must be non-violent. The aim is to raise public awareness about nuclear dangers and build political support for negotiations on a treaty banning nuclear weapons completely. This year will also focus on online actions to promote abolition, such as tweeting.
